All green fees, set up/clearance and bowls hire are included in the price. To protect the greens guests simply need to wear a pair of "flat-soled shoes " just socks or go barefoot (no shoes with heels or thongs). We also recommend even numbered groups of two or more .

A Few More Details:

WHEN CAN I PLAY?

Playing times are restricted to after the members competitions. That means after 4pm Tuesday to Sunday (the greens are rested on Mondays)

HOW OLD DO CHILDREN HAVE TO BE?

It is important that all children are supervised by their parents or another responsible adult at all times. We do not provide a child minding service but a sporting event. We do not specify a minimum age as children's ability between age groups will vary greatly. We have special light weight bowls to ensure within reason little feet are protected. Generally speaking the older children quickly become comfortable on the greens but the very young can play what is called "Junior Jack Attack". This is a special school based version of the game with soft rubber bowls. Again we supply all this equipment and instruction as part of the package.

HOW LONG DO WE PLAY FOR?

A minimum of 2 hours and up to 3 is the norm but you must of course finish before dark. However, we can also cater for special evening events (e.g.. Corporate days) under lights, if your group is large enough!

WHAT HAPPENS IF IT RAINS?

We have a cancellation policy (see booking form). However, if you still wish to play we can organise "Indoor Bowls" for you. This is played on special carpet rinks inside the Club House. Again we can cater for "Junior Jack Attack" as well.

WHAT ARE THE DRESS REGULATIONS?

Neat casual or sports clothing. Men's shirts must have a collar and no "offensive" logos or advertising on them. The Clubs dress rules also apply inside the Club.

ARE THERE ANY SPECIAL RULES I SHOULD KNOW?

Mostly its about good behaviour and that usually comes down to proper Parental supervision. The booking form explains this in more detail.

- In the event of unacceptable behaviour before or during the event or there is blatant disregard to the conditions of this contract the club reserves the right to terminate this contract with no reimbursement of booking fees. Being required.

Cancellation policy for Barefoot Bowls

- Full payment (cash or credit card) for the function/event must be made at least 3 days prior to the above booking date. Failure to do so will immediately involve cancellation of this booking.
- You booking is confirmed once you have received a copy of the Club confirmation above.
- Cancellations with at least 48 hours notice will be refunded or an alternate date can be booked at no charge. Otherwise a \$50.00 administration fee will apply.
- A full refund will be given in the event of bad weather conditions. However, you may choose to rebook another date or move your event inside the Club House as an indoor bowls game/s

Conditions

1. Bare feet, socks or flat rubber soled shoes only are allowed on the greens. No thongs allowed.
2. Children must be supervised by a responsible adult at all times.
3. No running, jumping or playing (other than bowls) on the greens at any time.
4. No food or drink is to be taken onto the greens.
5. No sitting on the bank (i.e. The top of the walls forming the ditches surrounding the greens).
6. Swearing or offensive behaviour will not be tolerated. This applies to all parts of the Club.
7. Maximum group of eight (8) persons per rink.
8. Try not to drop the bowls as this can cause considerable damage to the smooth green surfaces.
9. Club House Dress Regulations
 - Neat and tidy dress is required at all times on Club premises. The following dress regulations will be enforced after 8.30pm in all areas of the club.
 - Trousers, clean and tidy shirt, socks and shoes
 - Dress shorts, clean and tidy shirt
 - Sandals or leather dress shoes without socks
 - Long socks or sports socks and shoes

Not permitted at any time

- Hats and caps (male persons only)
- Peaked caps (males and females)
- Garments with offensive material
- Bare feet
- Dirty or torn clothing
- Bike pants
- Singlet's or gym wear (excluding bottle shop)
- Sleeveless shirts (males only)
- Swimwear (males and females)

Note

If a member or guest is dressed or appears in a way that may offend other members or guests, this is sufficient cause to refuse entry to the club

The above dress regulations are at the discretion of the Duty Manager and the decision of the Duty Manager is final
